FAIRBANKS, ALASKA

The 1980 annual meeting of the Western Association of Summer Administrators was held at the Fairbanks Inn, Fairbanks, Alaska, September 7 - 10. Then president **Jim Brisco** (California State University, Los Angeles) presided.

Paul Olscamp, President of Western Washington University, was the speaker at the first general session. His topic was "A University President Looks at Special Sessions."

The second general session speaker was **Ralph Mills**, Dean for Extended Education for the California State University System. His topic was titled "Jaws II."

At the meeting the following officers were elected:

Other business included discussion of the research grant program, its goal, fund limits and, review process.

It was agreed to place a \$1500 limit on funds granted in a single year, that awards be made in May, and that the year be from March to March.

Ken Loose, Director of Special Sessions, University of Calgary, is coordinating this program. He reports that, as of publication time, he has received one proposal.
