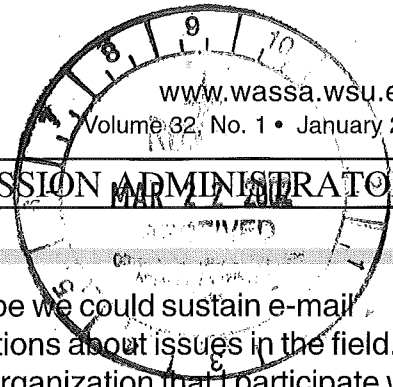

### Hawaii Is Site of 2002 WASSA Annual Conference

Plan now to attend the 2002 WASSA annual conference Wednesday through Sunday, September 4 to 8, on the island of Kauai, Hawaii. Hosting the event is Victor Kobayashi and Harriette Abe of the University of Hawaii, Manoa.

Conference events and lodging will be at Radisson Kauai Beach Resort near Lihui. The conference rate is \$109 for either a single or double room and the tax rate is 11.42%. There will be a \$20 per person per night charge for more than two persons in a room.

These rates are available for reservations made by August 1. The hotel has also agreed to extend the special rate four days before and four days after

the conference. A free shuttle bus runs between the airport and the hotel.

The annual conference planning committee will meet at the facility in February to finalize the program. Tentative conference theme is "Winds of Change."

Carol Switzer, 2001-2002 WASSA president, reports that the conference and facilities promise to be outstanding and she encourages everyone to make plans now to attend.
